Explora for Middle Schools	Search across multiple EBSCO databases at once with the interface <i>Explora for Middle Schools</i> . Retrieve search results from these databases: <i>History Reference Source, History Reference eBook Collection, Middle Search Plus, Middle Search Reference eBook Collection, Newspaper Source Plus, Science Reference Source, Science Reference eBook Collection, Topic Overviews K-5, and TOPICsearch</i>
SmartSearch (located on the Discus landing page)	Search across multiple databases at once. Your SmartSearch retrieves search results from the databases listed for <i>Explora</i> above plus the following: <i>Academic Search Premier, Bloom’s Literature, Britannica School, Business Source Premier, Computer Source, Education Full Text, Credo, Gale in Context: Biography, Gale in Context: Opposing Viewpoints, LEARN360, and more.</i>
